How do our families celebrate and does everyone do the same?

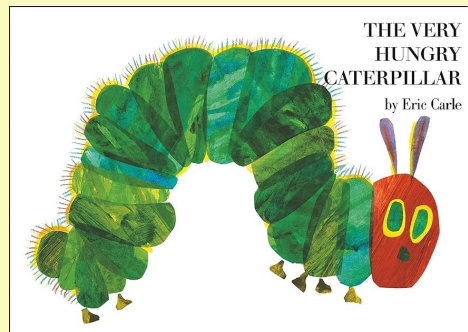


Literacy

Writing: Mark making. Using the laminated sheets to boost name recognition.

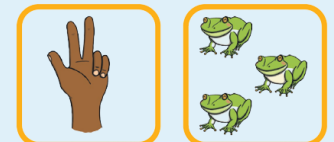
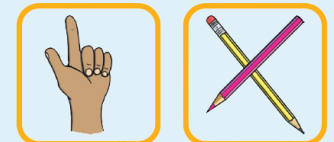

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<p>Communication & Language</p> <p>Listening Skills: Enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember much of what happens. Understand a question or instruction that has two parts, such as “Get your coat and wait at the door”.</p> <p>Speaking Skills: Know many rhymes, be able to talk about familiar books, and be able to tell a long story.</p>	<p>Physical Development</p> <p>Fine motor skills: Use one-handed tools and equipment, for example, making snips in paper with scissors. Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils.</p>	<p>Personal, Social, Emotional Development</p> <p>Being Me In My World Self –identity Understanding feelings Being in a classroom Being gentle Rights and responsibilities</p>	<p>Understanding the World</p> <p>Looking at the changing seasons from Autumn to Winter.</p> <p>Use all their senses in hands-on exploration of natural materials. Explore collections of materials with similar and/or different properties.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts & Design</p> <p>Learning Nativity Songs</p> <p>Remember and sing entire songs. Sing the pitch of a tone sung by another person (‘pitch match’).</p> <p>Create closed shapes with continuous lines, and begin to use these shapes to represent objects.</p>	<p>P.E.</p> <p>Sports Coach</p> <p>Gross Motor Skills: Balls skills – kicking, throwing catching skills. Scoring games.
