The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe

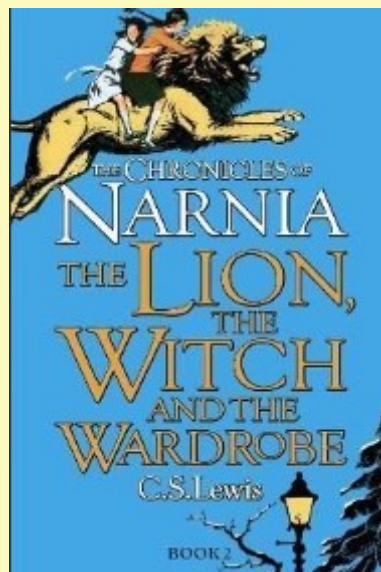
by C.S. Lewis

Fractions

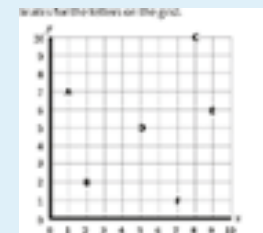
- Simplifying fractions
