



Literacy

Reading:


Can talk about the front cover of a book.


Writing:

Write own name independently.

Begin to use letter correspondences in play.

We shall use these books to explore and apply these skills.





Number:

Link numbers and amounts

Matching the right number of objects to match the numeral up to 5. Displays- quantities and numerals up to 5.

Experiment with their own symbols and marks as well as numerals Solve Real world mathematical problems with numbers up to 5.

Non-Number:

Spatial Reasoning & 2D/3D shape:

Select shapes appropriately: flat surfaces for building, a triangular prism for a roof etc.

Combine shapes: build increasingly complex constructions combining shapes to make a new one.

Measure

Make comparisons between objects relating to size, length, weight and capacity


Talk with children about everyday ways of comparing size, length, weight and capacity. Model lining up ends eg. Ribbons and discuss accuracy.

Spatial Reasoning:

Understand position through words alone e.g. The bag is under the table - with no pointing.

Describe a familiar route. Discuss routes and locations, using words like 'in front of' and 'behind.

Use spatial words like 'in, on, under, up, down, besides, between. Local walk and recall route.

Listening, attention and Understanding:

Play games involving turn taking.

Speaking:

Use terms such as in/out/on under/big/small.

Physical Development

Fine Motor Skills

Finger Gym activities— using tweezers to pick up pom poms/gripping objects with pegs.

Gross Motor Skills:

Squiggle While you Wiggle— Large movements with crayons to music.

God is Love: In a very simple way the concept of the Trinity, where God is three-in-one and each part loves the others and loves us.

Me, You and Us: Living in the Wider World helps children to extend their understanding of communities from Unit I, as they learn about the responsibilities they have to people, places and the planet now and increasingly as they get older.
