



Communication & Language

Listening, attention and Understanding:

Listing to instructions.

Listening to environmental sounds.

Knowing when to listen to my teachers.

Speaking:

To take turns with my friends and teachers when Navigating my new environment safely. speaking.

Physical Development

Fine Motor Skills:

Squiggle While you Wiggle: starting to make movements with my fingers to help me begin to grip things with control.

Gross Motor Skills:

Pushing, rolling, bouncing. Navigating my new environment safely

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

Story Sessions: Handmade with Love. Children will be told the story of creation, engaging with it creatively through sound, movement and discussion. This session aims to provide children at the outset of the programme with the language and understanding of the fundamental principle that we were created by God out of love and for love.

Understanding the World

Science: Main focus - Properties & Uses of Materials. Using The Gingerbread Man.

Geography: Name and locate area around Nursery and grounds and recognise features.

History: Why do we wear different clothes at different times of the year and different times of the day?

Expressive Arts & Design Creative Arts:

Make choices about which materials to use when creating. Bonfire Night — design their own fruit rocket.

Music:

Remember and sing entire songs. Sing the pitch of a tone sung by another person ('pitch match'). Nursery Rhyme Focus: Ten in the bed + Ten Green Bottles
