

Skills: To write effective sentences using: capital letters, full stops, question marks, finger spaces and co-ordinating conjunctions (for, and nor, but, or, yet, so).

Spelling Focus: /l/ sound spelt: '-le', '-el', '-il' and '-al'. /igh/ sound spelt with '-y'. Adding '-ies' to nouns and verbs.

Pupils practise addition and subtraction strategies as required.

Use number bonds to ten to add a single-digit number to a two-digit number.


Use number bonds to ten to subtract a single-digit number from a two-digit number.
